{/webgallery}The Municipality of Iasi is creating three new sports grounds with synthetic turf. This is about the sports grounds of the Theoretical Lyceum „Dimitrie Cantemir”, the „Alexandru cel Bun” Gymnasium and the National College „Mihai Eminescu”. The tender for the construction and installation of the three sports grounds had a budget of 849,414 lei, without TVA (1,010,802,66 lei, with TVA). The total value of the investment is 1,185,763 lei. The opening of offers took place on July 17 and there were two bidders: SC Atlas Company SRL and the association SC Ischia SRL – SC Con Ted Company SRL. As a result of the technical and financial analysis of the offers, the winner of the tender is SC Atlas Company SRL from Targu Mures, the value of the contract for the works being 766,185,5 lei, without TVA (911,760,75 lei, with TVA).

The contract for the works was signed by Mayor Mihai Chirica on Wednesday, August 29. The duration of execution of the works is four months from the date of the order to start the works, and the warranty period is 36 months from the date of acceptance of the works.

In parallel, the municipality is on its way to finalizing projects for the creation of two more sports grounds, this time with multifunctional surfaces, at the „Stefan Barsanescu” Gymnasium and the „Elena Cuza” Gymnasium. The tender for the contracting of the works for the two sports grounds will be launched in the coming period.

The projects are part of the municipality's plan to create sports grounds for many more schools and lyceums in Iasi. This is about 17 units of instruction: the National College, the National College „Costache Negruzzi”, the National College „Mihai Eminescu”, the National College „Octav Bancila”, the National College „Garabet Ibraileanu”, the Technical College „I. C. Stefanescu”, the Theoretical Lyceum „Dimitrie Cantemir”, the Technological Lyceum „Petru Poni”, the Economic Lyceum of Tourism, the „Stefan Barsanescu” Gymnasium, the „Titu Maiorescu” Gymnasium, the „Alexandru cel Bun” Gymnasium, the „Gh. I. Bratianu” Gymnasium, the „Alecu Russo” General School, the „Elena Cuza” Gymnasium, the „Bogdan Petriceicu Hasdeu” Gymnasium and the „Bogdan Petriceicu Hasdeu” – Corp D. Gymnasium.
